Incidents of Note (Since last parish Council meeting 17/12/2024)

- Nuisance vehicle reports all consisting of quad bikes and off-road motor bikes. On 22/12/24 it was reported 5 bikes being ridden by teenagers were riding on the pavement along Boyces Hill and some riders were without crash helmets. On 12/01/25 it was reported there were 5 bikes being ridden in the fields by Newington Primary School. And I also received an email reporting numerous incidents of quad bikes and off-road bikes being ridden along the footpath and into Cranbrook Wood throughout this month. Police attended the two calls and on both occasions they couldn't get close to the riders owing to them being spotted from afar and the riders able to travel across fields and squeeze through gaps the police unfortunately can't get through in a car. I thank those reporting these incidents as it helps me target certain areas and request extra resources. However, to stop this I will need names of those involved. - Vehicle Theft. There was a report of an attempt theft of a motor vehicle on 20/12/24 from the driveway of an address on The Willows. Thankfully vehicle owner was able to shout at the two males dressed in all black and they ran off before being able to break into the car or steal the vehicle itself.
